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AN entirely new climb up the East Peak of Lliwedd was made on October 3rd, 1908, by A. W. Andrews and J. B. Farmer. The Central Chimney [which lies about half-way between the Central Route (Route 1) and Route 2] was followed for a short distance, and a traverse then made to the right. The remainder of the climbing lay a short distance to the right of the chimney. Though continuously difficult, the climb is one of the most delightful on Lliwedd, as the rock is round and firm, and the holds, though small, are good. There are excellent belays and resting-places at the right intervals.

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
