

★ ★ 3 **Sea Mist** 30m HS 4a

A fine little route which is beginning to show the signs of its popularity. Start as for *Haze*. Climb diagonally leftwards to a ledge and then follow the arête forming the left-hand side of the grey wall to a ledge. Finish up the short headwall above.

★ 3 **Sea Mist** 30m HS 4a

4 **Sunset Boulevard** 24m E1 5b

Climb directly up the centre of the slab by a series of mantelshelves finishing direct. A left-hand variation, **Breaking Wind** (Lounds 18.7.84), has been climbed at a similar grade.

★ 5 **Pink 'Un** 24m VS 5a

Climb the prominent corner which bounds the right-hand side of the grey wall and pink slab to the overhang. Step left onto the slab to climb the continuation corner and final short headwall.

6 **Broade** 24m HS 4b

A slightly artificial line up the narrow wall forming the left-hand side of the corner immediately to the right of *Pink 'Un*.

The first corner to the right of *Pink 'Un*, identified by some red rock at its base.

The second corner right of *Pink 'Un*.

The third corner right of *Pink 'Un*.

The fourth corner right of *Pink 'Un*.

12 **Flake-Quake** 24m S

The wall 3 metres to the right of *Buff* to a good ledge at 8 metres, from where a flake-line leads to the top.

★ 13 **Fel Gŵyr** 24m D

Climb the rib between *Flake-Quake* and *Forgotten Corner*.

The fifth corner to the right of *Pink 'Un* has a tiny cave at its base.

15 **Small Beginnings** 24m D

The groove-line 3 metres right of *Forgotten Corner*.

- ★ **16 Nameless Wall 24m HS 4b**
Climb the broken wall 6 metres to the right of *Forgotten Corner*.

- 17 Follow the Chalk 24m VS 4b**
The long shallow corner to the right, starting just to the left of a cave.

- ★ **18 No Hands 24m VS 4c**
The crackline 9 metres right of *Forgotten Corner* with a cave containing a small pillar of rock at its base.

- 19 Smilin' Jugs 24m E3 5c †**
Climb *No Hands* for 6 metres then move right just below an obvious bulge. Climb direct over the bulge and finish more easily.

- ★ **20 Hands 24m E2 5b**
On the wall right of *No Hands* is a horseshoe-shaped niche. Climb up to this, and go through it and the next bulge to a short rightwards-slanting crack to finish.

- 21 Upon a Weatherbeaten Cliff 24m VS 4c**
The right-hand corner is climbed to a triangular block at 6 metres. This forces a delicate step up right into a niche. Regain and follow the groove until it is possible to traverse left beneath the final wall. Climb the steep wall on its left on good holds to the top.

- 22 Final Groove 21m D**
The wide crack in the big recess 9 metres to the right of *No Hands*. Climb the crack and then step left and finish up a groove on the left-hand side of the big recess.

This is the slabby face below the scrambling ridge descent south of the Main Face and above a series of rough ledges.

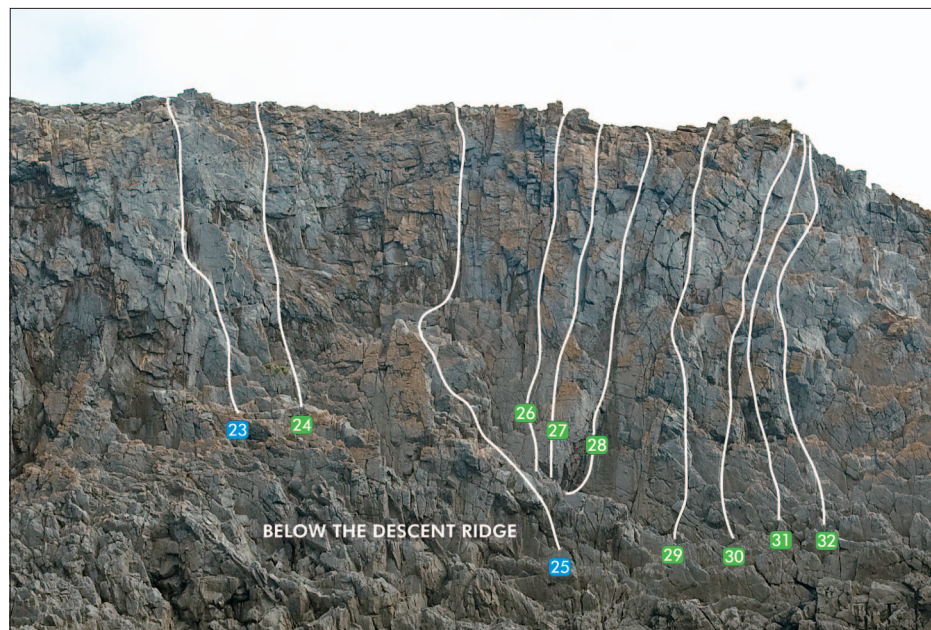
- 23 Gorgeous Grey Groove 20m VS 5a**
Climb the obvious grey right-facing groove on perfect rock and with good protection.

- 24 George 20m HS 4b**
The shallow groove between *Gorgeous Grey Groove* and *Stay Sharp 2* proves easier than it looks.

- 25 Stay Sharp 2 25m VS 4c**
Start 20 metres right of *Gorgeous Grey Groove* at the base of a slabby slanting groove. Climb the easy groove to the top of a block. Step up to below twin thin cracks and continue straight up on sharp pockets. Finish up the layback crack above.

- ★ **26 101 25m S 4a**
Climb the cracks and flakes in the slab to the right of the groove of *Stay Sharp 2* to twin cracks. Finish straight up on good holds to where the descent ridge narrows.

- 27 Family Sandwich 25m HS 4b**
The slim left-facing groove gained via a series of cracks and flakes in the slab. Finish up this on steep juggy ground.

28 Rocky Rides in Style 25m HS 4b

Start on the flat-topped block near the right-facing groove. Climb the groove to the steep slab and continue up the cracks in the vertical wall.

★ 29 Smelly Nelly 25m HS 4b

Start on some ledges near the flat-topped block. Climb cracks and flakes to the top of a small pinnacle and then follow the steep crack to a bay at the top of the wall.

30 Never in Doubt 25m S 4a

Climb the groove and rightwards-trending ramp on the right-hand side of the wall, finishing via a flake groove.

31 Big Girl's Blouse – Open Neck Variant 25m S 4a

Start 4 metres right of the groove of *Never in Doubt* and climb cracks in the steep wall to finish just right of *Never in Doubt*.

Start 6 metres right of the groove of *Never in Doubt* and climb up via cracks, a wall, and left-facing corner to finish up a short groove.

33 Assassination Run 21m E1 5a

Poorly protected. Start on a small sea pillar left of *First Time*. Step onto the face using an obvious spike and trend rightwards over two small ledges before climbing the face direct to a crack at the top.

34 First Time 45m HVS

1 21m 5a Move across the slabs to a small belay stance. This belay can be gained by traversing in from the east side of the headland at high-tide level.

2 24m 4c Step right and climb a fine groove to the top.
