Famed for its grooves, arêtes and slabby walls, Pant Ifan offers many clean geometric lines, stark and compelling in their simplicity. Precise footwork is essential on this crag, often in combination with a bold, determined approach; and a little ingenuity in seeking protection. The outlying wings offer contrasting experiences, with some esoteric gems out to the west that are well worth the slightly longer approach.
